The PlasticsEurope Fluoropolymer Product Group represents seven leading producers of fluoropolymers in Europe. Fluoropolymers, which include fluoroplastics and fluoroelastomers, are durable materials, whose chemical and thermal stability, together with other unique properties, are key to their use in numerous high-tech applications. Many of these properties are critical for human safety and health.

As you are likely aware, a number of competent authorities in Europe have indicated that a holistic group approach for PFAS needs to be explored for regulatory assessment and risk management. We would like to present our thoughts and dialogue with you on the development of an analysis of restriction options for PFAS.
