Åsa Webber pointed out that the protection and security of children including online is a priority for the Commissioner, and therefore welcomed the efforts of the companies that aim to do so. She pointed out that the Commission is preparing legislation to prevent and combat child sexual abuse more efficiently including certain obligations for the online service providers to detect child sexual abuse material, and invited Apple to provide further input and increase the exchanges at technical and senior levels on the fight against child sexual abuse and other relevant files.

Other topics discussed in the meeting were the “private relay”, a feature that, according to Apple, is opt-in and available only to subscribers of iCloud, as well as the implications of the Digital Markets Act.
