My name is [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Kreab Brussels. Earlier this week I spoke on the phone with one of your colleagues from DG ENV on a clarification of the legislative proposal on the Right to Repair as announced in the European Commission's Letter of Intent. Up until now our impression was that the Right to Repair in the EU would not be a singular legislative initiative, but rather a concept which we expected to be implemented through a series of different legislative and regulatory initiatives, among which the Sustainable Products Initiative and the initiative on Empowering Consumers for the Green Transition.

With the new proposal to be introduced, we are wondering whether you could give us some additional clarifications. Specifically, we are interested in understanding the framework of the expected 2022 legislative proposal on the Right to Repair, as currently it remains unclear whether this will be implemented by several related initiatives or by an all-encompassing new legislative proposal. In the event of the latter, it would be good to understand as well how the related initiatives will be influenced.
