Secondly, this is a kind reminder to provide us with your input/feedback on the Master file\_EU common list\_proposals 08.10-22.10 (see here: <u>Circabc (europa.eu)</u> by <u>Thursday 18 Nov COB</u>, by uploading your file in CIRCABC. Note that there are several 'High priority' issues, as these are pending issues for a long time or require your particular attention. The Masterfile indicates again which experts should be looking at which proposals.

Moreover, we are still awaiting input from the experts from the following countries concerning the current RAT common list (see enclosed): Belgium, Germany and Finland. We would be grateful for your input by <u>Thursday 18 Nov COB</u>.

Finally, we have received a specific request for your expert views on the use of a specific kind of COVID-19 test: the "gargle PCR self-test" (i.e., where the sample is collected by the tested person at home and subsequently returned and analysed in a laboratory). This test is frequently used in Vienna, Austria, and the Commission would like to know what your assessment is of the clinical performance of this PCR self-test. More specifically, would you consider it reliable enough to allow for the issuance of test certificates based on its result in the context of the EU Digital COVID Certificate? We would be grateful for your input by Thursday 18 Nov COB.
