Discussion points:

Commercial interests - Art 4(2) first indent

- DeliveryHero has a worldwide reach and operates in more than 10 markets within the EU. They are focusing on quick commerce (e.g. delivery of groceries within 20 minutes) and logistics as a service (second generation of online platforms). DH is interested in the DSA, DMA, AI, and platform workers files.
- On platform work: DH supports the initiative, including the clarification that voluntary benefits should not be reclassification factor, which could really make a difference. [REDACTED]
- DH believes France adopted an interesting position on platform work: Macron and Clement Beaune do not want black and white position on platform work. DH also referred to the Copenhagen Economics study arguing in favour of the freelance model and more flexibility.
- DH agrees on the importance of the collective bargaining guidelines as reclassification to self-employed could otherwise limit the right of some workers that will be under the EMPL platform work Directive
- EC Services mentioned need to protect vulnerable workers and that it is not very visible today what technological solutions are already offered to riders.
- DH asked for a meeting between its CEO and CFO, and Commissioner Breton.
