6.1 Overall conclusion on the level of compliance achieved

Official controls related to animal welfare are basically part of the risk based controls of animal holdings. Beside of this the authorities are performing controls in every case where suspicion of non-compliance is reported. In cases of detected non-compliance the operators have to remedy non-compliances, additional controls are carried out to check whether remedial actions have been carried out. In severe cases or by reoccurring non-compliances fines are imposed.

6.3 Analysis and action plan for animal welfare on farms

Recently, the prevention of routine tail curtailment is a high priority task of competent authorities. In the annual audit plan of establishments, the assessment of pig farms and the perception of possible curtailment was emphasized. Detailed central guides were released and the most relevant questions of the audit list were clarified. This area will also be scoped in the future.

6.5 Analysis and action plan for animal welfare during transport

Retrospective checks were important, whose expected rate was also defined in the annual audit plan. Furthermore, investigating of relevant Member States and international civilian organizations requests were investigated as high priority and suppliers of returning infringement behavior were sanctioned. During the summer extreme heat period, the ruminants' road transport was temporarily forbidden to some troublesome destinations (based on earlier administrative consequences) for several years.

6.6 Animal welfare at the time of killing

The statistical data for the last year will be sent to another way in accordance with regulations. Over the past period, the judgment of animals unsuitable for transport has been a priority. In this context, a strict and mandatory policy has been compiled via the central level.
