I hope you are doing well and you had a relaxing summer to recharge batteries.

I would like to briefly inform you that pressure is mounting in Germany on the rulebook for the delegated act on green hydrogen after the article that appeared in Der Spiegel over the weekend. I thought this would be helpful to know for you for the cross-cabinet discussion on this topic this week. There is a lot at stake in Germany. Please let me also clarify that the comment of our lead for the global hydrogen business, was not made in a letter to Ursula von der Leyen, but a comment on the ongoing discussion. So in case you were wondering, you did not miss any letter:)

Siemens Energy fully agrees with the analysis of the article and hopes — also in light of our decision to build a 1 GW factory in Berlin next year and ramp it up to 3 GW the following years — for a pragmatic rulebook that incentivizes investments in Europe. In particular a pragmatic approach to additionality, the temporal correlation and the treatments of imports is paramount. You might know that Germany intends to kick off H2 Global with a first call early next year that aims at H2 imports in form of ammonia, methanol and synthetic jet fuel. A stricter rulebook translates into higher costs and in consequence less green fuels for taxpayers's money.
