

Dear Mr Seibert, Mr Samsom, Mr Grassi and Mr Moutarlier,

Please find attached a letter addressed to Commission President Ursula von der Leyen by major European companies active in the field of hydrogen and renewable energy. The letter will also be sent by post.

The want to be a driving force behind the success of the European climate agenda and are personally committed to ensuring that the ramp-up of the hydrogen economy succeeds. Therefore, they wish to draw the President's attention to one very important issue that will largely determine whether major investments in renewable hydrogen will happen over the next few years: the design of the Delegated Act of the Renewable Energy Directive that defines the criteria under which hydrogen that draws electricity from the grid for its production can be considered renewable. The draft Delegated Act is currently being finalised under the auspices of DG ENER and, according to our information, should be published soon for public consultation.
