Along with my Ifri colleague I took part in the Stakeholder Session of the TTC meeting in Saclay last week.

As part of Ifri's on-going effort to analyze the development of European technology policies, we are setting up a seminar to assess the results of this last TTC. The goal is to discuss tech issues in a European-only setting, in order to build a stronger consensus amongst EU-members before the next TTC meeting at the end of the year. We are inviting high-level officials from European countries and the Commission, think-tankers and the private sector. There will be no press.

The seminar will be held at Ifri in Paris on June 30th, from 9:30am to 1pm (followed by lunch). Ifri will cover travel and one hotel night. If it is easier for you, online participation via Webex is also possible.

The first panel will look at the outcomes of the TTC May meeting: what are the positive creations (such as alert mechanisms in case of semi-conductors shortages; as well as for problematic online content), and the issues that may need more discussion. The second panel will focus on the ways we can ensure better digital democracy: what are the next steps to ensure an ethical AI? To better fund secure digital infrastructures at home and in third countries? How can we mitigate the environmental cost of digital developments?

We expect the group of 15-20 around the table to take part in a moderated discussion. Each panel will be introduced by 2 or 3 short presentations.

I would be delighted if you could join us and am at your disposal for more information.
