## **Minutes of Commissioner Reynders meeting with Apple CEO, Tim Cook**

- Commissioner Reynders and Mr. Cook underscored the shared goal of strengthening privacy and security in the digital sphere. They discussed the cooperation for the GDPR enforcement, compliance with the DMA, and the DSA, as well as the ongoing efforts in the context of AI regulation.
  - Commissioner Reynders stressed the need to comply with competition rules and the DMA. He welcomed Apple's efforts in this direction and expressed the need for a fast convergence on the right path forward.
  - The importance of sustainable products and value chains, and of empowering consumers to make informed choices were also discussed.
  - The two agreed to continue to collaborate on these issues, notably on meeting all requirements laid out in the DMA by March 2024 and protecting privacy and security.
