Subject: Literature review of the "Réseau Environnement Santé" on Bisphenol A

On 21 January the "Réseau Environnement Santé" has informed us on the compilation on studies on Bisphenol A (BPA) which resulted from their monitoring of literature. The compilation comprises studies published between January and September 2012 concerning exposure to BPA and health impacts linked to BPA (see attached).

EFSA is currently on its own initiative re-evaluating Bisphenol A taking account of the new scientific information which became available since 2010. The publication of the opinion is planned for May 2013.


