



**Summary:** Meeting short of immediate progress on substance but successful in keeping the negotiating process on track. Both co-legislators committed to constructively address the continuing differences of positions. Significant amount of work delegated to technical level, on both net neutrality and roaming.

Commission committed to provide a technical non-paper as regards roaming, to complement the earlier

one on net neutrality. The date for the next trilogue still uncertain, to be decided only in two weeks' time, after the Telecoms Council meeting of 12 June.
