We refer to your e-mail of 5 August in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 7 August under the above mentioned reference number.

The Danish adoption agency letter to which you refer to in your e-mail mentions that the Swedish central authority for adoption was informed on the matter to which you refer. From this, no clear conclusion can be drawn that the Swedish authorities actually received a letter in that respect.

The Commission services have conducted an extensive search for the document you requested in your mail of 5 August. We regret to inform you that no documents have been found that would correspond to the description given in your application.
