This is in response to an urgent call for proposals for funding from the UK's leading social sciences funding body (ESRC), for which we have been shortlisted. The submission deadline is 6 July 2015.

The aims of our proposal are as follows:

- To map the journeys and document the experiences of refugees and migrants who have recently crossed the Mediterranean Sea by boat.
- To assess the impact of policy interventions across the Mediterranean from the perspective of refugees and migrants.

This will focus specifically on identifying the effects of recent anti-smuggling measures, search and rescue, and preventative mechanisms on migratory journeys and experiences.

• To provide up-to-date findings and analyses that intervene in academic and public debates and that inform policy developments and practitioner responses on the basis of a sound evidence base, while also preparing for on-going

practitioner responses on the basis of a sound evidence base, while also preparing for on-going collaborative outputs and funding opportunities

The project will start in September 2015, and will last for 24 months in total. The team involves collaborators in Italy, Malta and Greece. Interviews will be conducted in three key sites where migrants crossing the Mediterranean arrive either directly by boat or following a rescue operation: Kos (Greece), Sicily (Italy), and Malta. These will be followed up with interviews during the early summer of 2016, in order to ensure that a second round of data collection can be undertaken during the season when migratory crossings are highest.




