## Request for Documents under the Access to Public Administration Files Act 2013, Act No. 606.


Dear Katharina Klein,

By e-mail dated 21 April 2016 you have requested access to “a list of meetings with detailed minutes or any other reports of such meetings between members of the Danish Permanent Representation and the third parties listed below in which the health impacts of sugar intake, the reformulation and/or labelling of sugar-sweetened products and/or the drop of the sugar quotas in the EU was discussed. [The third parties are listed]”

The right of public access to documents for people who are not parties to a case is regulated by the Access to Public Administration Files Act no. 606 of 12 June 2013 (Offentlighedsloven) paragraph 7 (1).

The Permanent Representation of Denmark to the EU has conducted a search in the Representation's record system etc. for documents of the nature mentioned in your request. The Representation has not identified the documents which are deemed as falling within the scope of your request. For your information the Representation has used the search words “sugar” in combination with all the listed companies.

We can inform you that the Danish Permanent Representation has met with Kellogg's on 29 October 2015 and with UNESDA on 25 February 2016 but we do not have detailed minutes or any other reports of these meetings.
