Fact of the case

On 14th of August at 12.32, Ita/Navy Borsini in position [redacted], has sighted and intercepted a wooden boat with 113 irregular migrants on board. SAR event was declared one dead body being discovered on the boat and two persons were in critical health conditions. One of them was transported by helicopter to Lampedusa where arrived dead. Intoxication with monoxide fumes from the boat engine is probably cause of death of the two irregular migrants. All the other migrants were rescued.
