We refer to your e-mail dated 02/03/2016 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 02/03/2016 under the above mentioned reference number.

Your application is currently being handled. However, we will not be in a position to complete the handling of your application within the time limit of 15 working days, which expires on 30/03/2016. An extended time limit is needed as (part of) the documents requested originate from third parties which have been consulted.
