Request for access to Frontex documents

Dear Mr Blanco,

With reference to your request received on 27/04/2016 asking for documents containing data of the Joint Return Operations (JROs) coordinated by Frontex, for 2006-2016, I am pleased to inform you that Frontex agrees to provide you with the attached requested document.

The document contains the following informations: date of departure of the flight, organising country or countries, nationality of the people that have been involved in the JROs -Monitors/Observes, total no. of returnees, and cost of each JRO.

The departure airport is normally the capital city of the organising member state, except in the Netherlands, where it is usually Rotterdam, and in Germany, where it depends on the Federal State organising the JRO (Dusseldorf, Stuttgart, Hannover, Berlin and Munich).

The destination airport is always the capital city of the country of destination.

I hope you will find this document useful.

I would like to remind you that the copyright of the document is with Frontex and that the existing rules on copyright may limit your right to reproduce or exploit the released documents.
