## 3. Services aspects in post-Nairobi WTO

<b>COM</b> [Art. 4(1)(b)] briefed the Committee on the EU priorities related to services in the WTO/post-Nairobi context, including those outlined in the COM background paper on "A Digital Trade Initiative in the WTO" presented to the TPC Full Members of 28 April 2016.
Out of the scope of the request
expressed interest in work advancing in all services aspects in the WTO, including domestic regulation in services and digital trade; supported exploratory work on the scope/participation on digital trade and asked if there could be any deliverables envisaged already for MC11.
Other interventions focused only on digital trade. Many [*] took floor to support potential work on digital in the WTO context and called for the EU to lead [*].
