We refer to your e-mail dated 29/01/2013 in which you make a request for access to documents registered under the above mentioned reference number.

Your application concerns correspondence between citizens and other and the office of the President and the responsible Vice-President and with the responsible directorate related to the Commission preparation for attendance at and follow up from the EURSC Board of governors meeting 3-5 December 2012.

Having examined the documents requested under the provision of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents, I have come to the conclusion that they may be partially disclosed. Some parts of the documents have been blanked out as their disclosure is prevented by exception to the right of access laid down in Article 4 of this Regulation. The disclosure of these parts would undermine the protection of privacy and integrity of the individual, in particular in accordance with Community legislation regarding the protection of personal data.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
