Subject: Reply concerning request to access information

Dear Ms Zuckerstätter.

Reference is made to your e-mail of 22 September 2016, with registration number 2048, requesting access to EASO documents with data and information about migrants and asylum seekers in Austria between 2014 and 2016.

The European Asylum Support Office (EASO) has treated your request for documents as a request which falls under Regulation No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents, which also applies for EASO documents. Moreover, the EASO Management Board adopted on 20 September 2011 its Decision No 6 laying down practical arrangements regarding public access to the documents of EASO.

EASO does not have any data on immigrants in Austria. These can be requested to the relevant Austrian authorities.

As far as the requested data on asylum seekers in Austria are concerned, EASO considers that these documents fall under the exceptions provided for in Article 4 (3) of EU Regulation No 1049/2001, as the data contained in these documents have been drawn up by a third party for the agency's internal use in the context of the agency's work in the field of data collection and analysis. In this context, we regret to inform you that it has been decided to refuse the disclosure of the requested documents.
