AWARD DECISION

Grant award procedure:

Proposal under the Internal Security Fund – Borders and Visa Emergency Assistance (Application ref. no: HOME/2016/ISFB/AG/EMAS/0030)

HAVING REGARD to Articles 128 (1) and 133 (2) of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union (hereafter referred to as “the Financial Regulation”), and in particular,

HAVING REGARD to Articles 190 (1) and 204 (5) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1268/2012 of 29 October 2012 on the rules of application of the Financial Regulation (hereafter referred to as “the Rules of Application”),

HAVING REGARD to Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 laying down general provisions on the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and on the instrument for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating crime, and crisis management,

HAVING REGARD to Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 establishing the Instrument for financial support for external borders and visa,

HAVING REGARD to Commission Implementing Decision C/2015/9531 of 15 December 2015 adopting the Work Programme and the financing for Emergency assistance in the framework of the Internal Security Fund – the instrument for financial support for external borders and visa for the year 2015 for the budget line 18 02 01 01 – Support of borders management and a common visa policy to facilitate legitimate travel as amended by Commission Implementing Decision C/2016/1567 of 10 March 2016,

Whereas:


1. Grants for emergency assistance may be awarded under Article 14 of Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 to support Member States in situations resulting from an urgent and exceptional pressure where a large or disproportionate number of third-country nationals are crossing or are expecting to cross the external border of one or more Member States or any other duly substantiated emergency situation requiring urgent actions at the external borders;

2. Grants for emergency assistance may be awarded without a call for proposals as specified in Commission Implementing Decision C/2015/9531, as amended by Commission Implementing Decision C/2016/1567;
3. An evaluation committee was appointed pursuant to Article 204 (1) of the Rules of Application in order to evaluate the project proposal submitted and issue a recommendation to the Authorising Officer;
4. An evaluation was carried out pursuant to Articles 133 (1) and (2) of the Financial Regulation and 204 (1) of the Rules of Application;

I HEREBY DECIDE:

1. To award a maximum amount of EUR 6,175,260.00 for a grant to the applicant listed in Annex 1.
