We are pleased to inform you that the two above-mentioned applications have been positively evaluated on the basis of the award criteria established in the work programme and the financing for emergency assistance within the framework of the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and the Internal Security Fund – Borders and Visa.

The Commission acknowledges the urgent need for emergency assistance to Greece. However, the Evaluation Committee considered that the level of 6,74% of indirect costs is not fully justified by the nature of the action, and has consequently recommended to reduce it to a maximum of 4%. This is why the maximum EU contribution has been established at EUR 52,200,000 for HOME/2016/AMIF/AG/EMAS/0042 and EUR 6,175,260 HOME/2016/ISFB/AG/EMAS/0030.

In addition, in view of the preparation of the respective Grant Agreements, some technical issues need to be further clarified. You will be contacted shortly by our services to send the requested information.

Please note that the present letter does not represent any commitment on the part of the Commission and could not constitute a ground to claim any expectations concerning the signature of a Grant Agreement. The Commission may, until the agreement is signed by both parties, either abandon or cancel the procedure without this entitling you to any compensation.
