We refer to your e-mail dated 23 January 2014 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 27 January under the above mentioned reference number.


Your application is currently being handled. However, we will not be in a position to complete the handling of your application within the time limit of 15 working days, which expires on 17 February 2014.
