We refer to your email dated 18 May 2017 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 19 May 2017 under the above-mentioned reference number.

Your request concerns all access to documents requests sent to ECHA on glyphosate (minus CEO's) since 01 January 2016.

Your application is currently being handled. However, we will not be in a position to complete the handling of your application within the time limit of 15 working days.
