In terms of content, the draft measure voted today provides for an extension of the existing approval by 6 months after the opinion of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) about the hazard classification of glyphosate, or 31.12.17, whatever is earlier. The ECHA opinion has to be delivered by 30/11/17, but is expected already for summer 2017.
