Request for access to Frontex documents

Dear Ms Izuzquiza,

This letter is to respond to your application received on 12 July 2017, requesting documents related to the meeting that took place on 11 July 2017 between Frontex's Executive Director and representatives of Italy and EU Member States, precisely:

- any record of the aforementioned meeting. This may include, but not necessarily limited to, minutes of the meeting, verbatim reports of the meeting, transcripts etc. that would provide a record of the proceedings of the meeting;
- a list of the participants in the meeting, or any document which contains the names and (EU or Member State) agency or institution the participants represent;
- the agenda of the meeting;
- any documents used and/or exchanged during the course of the meeting;
- any documents produced by Frontex for the purpose of the meeting.

I am pleased to inform you that Frontex agrees to provide you with requested documents. Please note, however, that given that some limited parts of the documents fall under an exception to public access to documents as stipulated in Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of 30 May 2001, they have been removed with a detailed justification next to them.

Please find the documents in the attachment. I hope you will find them useful.

I would like to remind you that the copyright of the documents rests with Frontex and that the existing rules on copyrights may limit your right to reproduce or exploit the released documents.
