as discussed over the phone already, we do not have any suggestions for competition-related topics for the agenda of the Regulatory Co-operation Forum established under CETA.

The reason is that we have a specific instrument for cooperation with Canada in the competition field, namely the Agreement regarding the application of competition laws, and we are currently finalising a 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation Cooperation Agreement with our Canadian counterparts. Besides, we cooperate with Canada through ICN and OECD.
