The objective of the meeting was to discuss progress in the FTA negotiations on rules of origin with Mercosur and for tobacco products.

[Out of the scope of the request]

Most of the companies supported the rule of origin based on 10% of originating tobacco as a horizontal rule for all EU FTAs that ensures consistency and possibility to source tobacco globally.

The Commission presented the state of play of the negotiations on rules of origin. Both Mercosur and tabled more restrictive rules for cigarettes that the EU. Mercosur is the third biggest producer of tobacco in the world, and the biggest supplier of tobacco to the EU.

[Out of the scope of the request] . The ir provided some additional information about production of tobacco and production of cigarettes about the quantities imported from MERCOSUR in the manufacturing of European cigarettes.
