Subject: Your application for access to documents – Ref GestDem No 2018/2326

We refer to your e-mail dated 25/04/2018, in which you make a request for access to documents, registered 26/04/2018 under the above-mentioned reference number, as well as your clarifications received on 18/05/2018

We regret to inform you that the Commission does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.<sup>1</sup>

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

For the sake of information, please note that EPSC met with Facebook on two occasions, as notified on the webpage listing the meetings between myself and external stakeholders<sup>2</sup>:

- i) on 28/06/2015, for a lunch "Tech Needs Women" organised by Facebook, and
- ii) on 20/09/2016, a bilateral meeting.
