With regard to the preparation of CBA in the PCI process, as you know, it was the promoters' final responsibility to prepare the CBA and they have decided to give the official mandate to run the CBA assessment to ENTSO-G. According to its mandate, ENTSO-G has shared the CBA information regarding the assessed group of projects only with the promoters of that specific group and not with other project promoters or third parties. Therefore, it is our faculty as a promoter to obtain consent from the other promoters part of the SGC_01 group if we would like to share the CBA results with third parties.

As you may know from publicly available sources, TAP is looking for financing from external sources, such as the European Investment Bank (*EIB*). As part of its assessment, the EIB is interested in seeing a CBA.
