Please find attached the monthly report. Please note that WFP carried out some GFA distributions to speed up the absorption.

Currently, WFP is identifying with the ministry some additional schools to fully use up the tonnage, and WFP expects that all the remaining milk quantities (some 7,600 mt) will be dispatched under the school meals programme during April and May. Accordingly, no further distribution of milk through GFA is expected, though operational conditions on the ground may change.

I am happy to meet with you. As the progress seems on track I suggest we meet at our level however, if you wish to include also [REDACTED], kindly let me know and I'll activate [REDACTED].

We are happy to increase the frequency (verbal/written) of our interactions in the coming weeks to monitor the progress of distributions and discuss any remedial action, if needed.
