Phone call on Indonesia with representative of the European Federation of Sporting Goods industry, 11 April 2016

The European Federation of Sporting Goods industry ^{art 4(1)(b)} called me to inquire about the state of play of the negotiations for a CEPA with Indonesia.

I explained where we stand and that we are working to make progress on scoping discussions.

art 4(1)(b) said that the Federation has a very important interest in negotiations with Indonesia; currently, brand footwear is designed in Europe and produced in Indonesia, the supply chain is interconnected. One of the Federation's major concerns is the EU high tariff protection for footwear. I explained where we stand and that we are working to make progress on scoping discussions.

art 4(1)(b) promised he would provide additional information on other concerns with Indonesia and will closely monitor the situation.
