I am contacting you to see whether it might be possible for Vice-President Timmermans to make some time available on the afternoon of Wednesday 27 January to receive His Eminence Cardinal Reinhard Marx, Archbishop of Munich and Freising, and President of the Commission of the Bishops' Conferences of the European Community (COMECE). It would be a matter of a visit lasting between ten and fifteen minutes.

The Cardinal will be in Brussels for a meeting of the Standing Committee of COMECE and wishes to avail of this opportunity to engage in a brief discussion with the Vice-President within the understood terms of the implementation of the dialogue between the EU and the Churches and Religious Communities under article 17 TFEU with the First Vice-President of the European Commission.
