Thank you for your follow up question in relation to your request for access to documents, as referenced above.

Following your question, we contacted the division, which was invited to the meetings with Facebook. They confirmed that we hold no minutes of the meetings as per your previous request, but have now identified email correspondence which related to the invitations to the meetings.

As regards the incoming invitation emails from Facebook to the EEAS, we were – in accordance with Article 4.4 of Regulation 1049/2001 – obliged to consult the third party concerned on possible disclosure of their documents. I am pleased to inform you that we have received a positive reply from Facebook to release our correspondence with them to the public, which I therefore attach to this letter.
