Jean,

I will be in Brussels next week (MAr. 18-23) with reps from CropLife America (for whom I now consult) and the American Chemistry Council to explore our concerns with DG ENV's proposed regulations for endocrine disruptors. We will attend the Mar. 20 meeting of stakeholders which EFSA will use to present their views. We also want to meet with various officials from the Commission, the EP and the private sector to explore our concerns which are: 1) the proposed regs do not appear to be consistent with the EU's obligations under the SPS Agreement; and 2) the regs do not appear to be consistent with the objectives of the U.S.-EU negotiations for a TTIP.

I'm assuming you are still in the SecGen's office. Would you have time to meet with our delegation next week? Are there other people you would suggest we meet with?
