In accordance with Articles 4.4 and 4.8 of the IMI2 JU Governing Board Rules of Procedure ("the Rules of Procedure"), an extraordinary Board meeting was called on 22 May 2018 and held by audio conference.
The quorum was met pursuant to Article 7 of the Rules (Annex II) and the agenda approved (Annex I).
As the Chair of the Governing Board was left vacant following Ms Signe Ratso's reassignment on 16 April 2018, the resulting assumed chairing duties for the beginning of the meeting.
No potential or manifest conflict of interest was declared by any of the Governing Board Members.
The Deputy-Chairperson proposed that Mr Wolfgang Burtscher be elected as new Chairperson of the Governing Board for the remainder of the European Commission's term of office, pursuant to Article 2 of the Rules of Procedure.
The Governing Board elected Mr Burtscher as Chairperson of the Governing Board, after which Mr Tellier handed over chairing duties to the newly elected Chairperson for the remainder of the meeting.
