We hereby would like to reply to your request of 5 July 2019, which was registered under reference Ares(2019)4426152.

You have requested access to "*the travel expenses of REA's Director, for the period 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2018 inclusive*".

More precisely, you have asked for "*documents that contain, for each of the trips, the following information:*

- *Place of origin and destination, and the amount spent on travel or transportation;*
- *Exact dates and duration of the trip;*
- *Amount spent on accommodation;*
- *Amount spent on subsistence;*
- *Other information, such as possible miscellaneous costs".*
