Thank you for your email

First of all, [REDACTED] and speaking for the members of this Temporary Working, I reconfirm the interest of the members and [REDACTED] to participate in the EU Battery Alliance.

As summarised during the Oct 11 meeting, the TWG, with a lead ensured by Industrials, has proposed several technological and non-technological R&I actions and flagships.

In a holistic view, looking forward, considering the full battery value circle, the Implementation Plan should provide the blueprint of the EU strategy on batteries. What is also important is that the Plan consider batteries for e-mobility but also for stationary. The plan is currently in its endorsement phase.
