### *LNG*

EU noted that it is a strong US interest to export more LNG to the EU. On our side we have made significant infrastructure investment and diversification is a crucial element of the EU's energy security. The US noted that it is also working domestically on enhancing its infrastructure and that it is looking into what amendments could be done to the US Natural Gas Act that could eliminate the licensing requirements for the EU [Art. 4.1(a)]
