#### Main issues discussed

- Upon request by Art. 4.2 representatives, on 3 March 2019 DG Trade Director Martin-Prat met Art. 4.2

- Points of discussions were the latest state of play of the EU-China investment negotiations, China's reforms of its domestic foreign investment laws as well as Art. 4.2 's current operations in China and Europe.
- Ms Martin-Prat informed that the 20th round of negotiations took place at the end of February and that it marked the commencement
  of very sector-specific discussions in light of the exchange of market access offers occurred in the margins of the 2018 EU-China
  Summit. Despite the progress already made and a significant level of engagement, still a lot of work lies ahead, in particular in terms
  of ambition of the Chinese offer.
- With regard China's draft foreign investment law currently under review by the National People's Congress, Ms Martin-Prat welcomed China's objective to open up further and to actively promote and protect foreign investments.
