As you know, the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan became a Contracting Party to the Energy Charter Treaty on 11 December 2018 following the ratification of the Treaty by the Parliament in April 2018. The Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources of Jordan requested the Secretariat to organise a training programme for their government officials to learn more about the Energy Charter Process and global energy developments. The training will take place on 18-21 March 2019 in Amman, Jordan.
