**Subject: Your e-mail concerning your applications for access to documents under Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 - GESTDEM 2020/1246**

Dear Ms Dadci,

I refer to your e-mail of 20 April 2020, registered on the same day, in which you submitted a confirmatory application, in accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup> (hereafter ‘Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001’).

Your confirmatory application was submitted in relation to your initial application of 2 March 2020, addressed to the Directorate- General for Energy, whereby you requested access to, I quote:

- ‘ all correspondence (including email) between 1st January 2019 and 2nd March 2020 between the former/current Commissioner for Energy and/or his/her cabinet and/or officials and representatives of DG Energy on one hand and representatives from BusinessEurope, the European Roundtable of Industrialists (ERT) and GasNaturally on the other, in which the European Green Deal was addressed.;
- list of meetings between 1st January 2019 and 2nd March 2020 between officials and representatives of DG Energy on one hand and representatives from BusinessEurope, the European Roundtable of Industrialists (ERT) and GasNaturally on the other, in which the European Green Deal reform was addressed;

As you did not receive the reply from the above-mentioned Directorate-General within the statutory time limits, you submitted, on 20 April 2020, the confirmatory application.

I note, however, that on 15 June 2020, the Directorate-General for Energy provided you the reply to your initial application.

As the Directorate-General for Energy has in the meantime sent you a full reply to your application, the Secretariat-General will close this confirmatory application. Please note that this is without prejudice to your right to submit a new confirmatory application if you do not agree with the position of the Directorate-General for Energy, as reflected in its reply of 15 June 2020.
