Between Commissioner Kadri Simson and Eurelectric, ENEL SpA, Eesti Energia Aktiaselts (Eesti Energia AS), innogy SE, Energias de Portugal SA (EDP), ELECTRICITE DE FRANCE (EDF), ESBVattenfall, IBERDROLA(IBE), discussing risk-preparedness in electricity sector; impact of crisis on clean energy investments; priorities of electricity sector for the upcoming energy initiatives under the Green Deal on the 15/04/2020/.
