1. Summary of FVO Assessment of the Action Plan

		<p>requirements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• FSA are in the process of purchasing a measuring device to record the electrical parameters in water bath stunners and will have trained employed Veterinary staff on use of this equipment by the end of this year.• FSA check list for approvals has been amended to include a question on line speed.• Revised operational instructions regarding the implementation of 1099/2009 outside approved slaughterhouses were published by the APHA on 15 October 2014 in Scotland and Wales.• APHA have worked closely with FSA and representatives of the Local Authorities to develop better communications especially on providing feedback to FSA OV's on welfare issues identified at slaughterhouses. A system has been agreed, and changes to APHA operational instructions have been drafted.	
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
