Commissioner followed the detailed lines as indicated in the attached briefing. She referred to the Green Deal, the upcoming transport strategy, the place of transport in the European recovery plan, road safety high on her agenda, digitalisation and access to data and alternative fuels infrastructure.

Kind regards

FIA President stressed road safety is very important for the clubs and that they would like to work with us on the ongoing initiatives. Same message for digitalisation and ITS as well as CCAM and alternative fuels infrastructure.

He insisted that manufacturers should not monopolise the data which belong to the consumer. FIA wants free access to data and consumers should have a say on what is done with their data.

On the European Green Deal he would welcome a Regulatory Framework coordinating the different national frameworks. Important for FIA not to push the bill of decarbonisation on the consumer.

Both sides welcomed reinforced cooperation.

FIA invited Commissioner to the Euroboard (FIA Region I Management Board) that will take place in Brussels on the 5<sup>th</sup> of November in the presence of Commissioner happily accepted the invitation.
