AWARD DECISION

Grant award procedure: Proposals under the Asylum, Migration and Integration

Fund – Emergency Assistance

Application ref.: HOME/2019/AMIF/AG/EMAS/0107

HAVING REGARD to Articles 189, 195 and 200 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 (hereafter referred to as "the Financial Regulation"),

HAVING REGARD to Commission Implementing Decision C(2020)4360 of 6 July 2020 adopting the Work Programme and the financing for emergency assistance in the framework of the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) for the year 2020 for the budget line 18 03 01 01 – Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund – Strengthening and developing the Common European Asylum System and enhancing solidarity and responsibility sharing between the Member States.

Whereas:

- 1. grants for emergency assistance may be awarded under Article 21 of Regulation (EU) No 516/2014 to support Member States in a situation resulting from:
 - i. heavy migratory pressure in one or more Member States characterised by a large and disproportionate inflow of third-country nationals, which places significant and urgent demands on their reception and detention facilities, asylum systems and procedures;
 - ii. the implementation of temporary protection mechanisms within the meaning of Directive 2001/55/EC; or
 - iii. heavy migratory pressure in third countries where refugees are stranded due to events such as political developments or conflicts.
- 2. grants for emergency assistance may be awarded without a call for proposals as specified in Commission Implementing Decision C(2020)4360;

- 3. an evaluation committee was appointed pursuant to Article 150 of the Financial Regulation;
- 4. an evaluation procedure was carried out pursuant to Article 200 of the Financial Regulation;
- 5. the evaluation committee has established an evaluation report¹ in conformity with Article 200(4) of the Financial Regulation;

I HEREBY DECIDE:

1. to award a maximum amount of **EUR 43 232 858.48** for a grant to the applicant listed in Annex 1. This top-up would bring the total amount of the action to EUR **49 649 406.08** (EU contribution).
