- minutes of the meetings/videocalls/calls mentioned above

We wish to inform you that, insofar it concerns documents from DG Competition (see below), the Commission does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

Please note that due to the wide scope of your request, covering also areas falling under the responsibility of other Directorates-General, parts of your request have been attributed to other Directorates-General. This reply relates only to the documents of DG Competition. You will receive the replies from the other respective Directorates-General in due course.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.
