Dear Ms Changoe,

I refer to your application dated 20/06/2021, in which you make a request for access to documents under Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001¹ ('Regulation 1049/2001'), registered on 21/06/2021 under the above mentioned reference number.

You request access to:

All documents - including but not limited to minutes, (hand-written) notes, audio recordings, verbatim reports, operational conclusions, lines to take, e-mails, and presentations, correspondence (i.e. any emails, correspondence, telephone call notes, and/or text messages including WhatsApp exchanges) – related to meetings held between Paolo Garzotti - Head of the Latin America Unit- and representatives of companies and business associations on issues related to the EU Mercosur Free Trade Agreement.

We regret to inform you that we do not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application since Mr Garzotti did not have such meetings since he took over his position.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L 145, 31.5.2001, p. 43).

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by DG Trade, DG Trade is not in a position to fulfil your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
