In recent weeks, there have been multiple news reports pointing towards the delay of the Sustainable Corporate Governance initiative. Similarly, some of its key elements seem to be at risk such as an ambitious scope (while proportionate in nature), clear enforcement and liability (essential to create a functional framework) as well as ensuring the EU follows the latest climate and environmental science (fundamental to align companies sustainability targets with EU policy goals)

Leading NGOs working on corporate transparency and responsibility stress the role of this initiative to ensure coherence and alignment within the corporate and financial market regulatory framework in Europe following the Sustainable Finance Agenda and the EU Green Deal.

While transparency is a first positive step, it is not enough to ensure corporate behaviour is shifted towards sustainability. For this reason, it is vital to achieve the objectives of both parts of the sustainable corporate governance initiative, which is set to provide solutions to two issues:

1. address the lack of a European legal framework for corporate human rights and environmental due diligence

2. identify how corporate governance can foster sustainability and long-term thinking

Expert NGOs have prepared the attached paper focusing on key recommendations to help clarify directors' responsibilities to oversee sustainability that fully fit with existing company law and corporate governance frameworks across Europe. The briefing follows a public letter sent to DG Justice Commissioner Didier Reynders and Executive Vice-President Frans Timmermans expressing our support and extensive evidence backing the EU Commission plans on Sustainable Corporate Governance and responding to recent criticism.

The NGOs are presenting detailed recommendations for the latter part of the initiative. The involvement of boards is paramount to ensure that companies are able to consider and take the necessary strategic decisions with regards to the management of sustainability risks and impacts, and integrate them in overall corporate strategies and business operations. Connecting the dots between companies' sustainability reporting and upcoming due diligence obligations requires effective governance and oversight from the company's senior management and the board.

Our proposals are therefore divided into two categories to ensure an effective reform:

- Package 1. Board oversight over sustainability strategies, risks and impacts which is intrinsically connected to due diligence, and thus should be explored as part of a single proposal
- Packages 2 and 3 outline other supportive reforms in the field of corporate governance tackling alignment of incentives and board composition in order to promote good practice and provide safeguards against malpractice

The reforms explored by the Commission to clarify directors' role in overseeing sustainability and due diligence are based on best practice and are coherent with existing key aspects of company law and corporate governance codes across Europe.

While these vary from one Member State to the next, the Commission's proposals broadly fit within the framework of existing directors' duties, thus enabling Member States and companies to integrate proposed legislative reforms in line with their specific company laws and practice.
